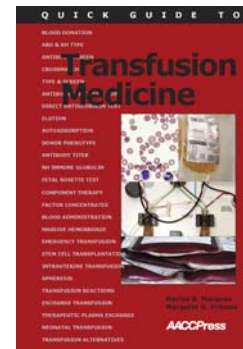
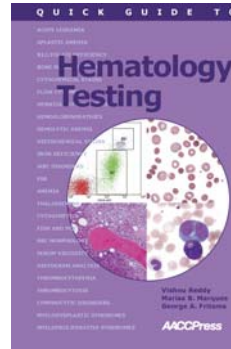
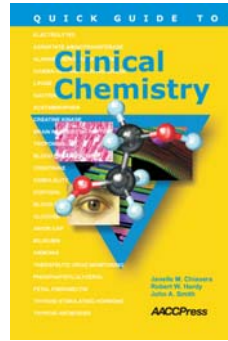
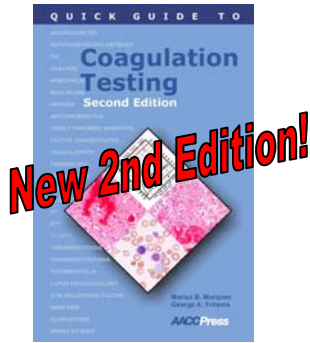


# The Quick Guide Laboratory Series
